<i>Municipales</i>	6 years	2020	Town/City Mayor and Council
<i>Départementales</i>	6 years	2021	<p>2 representatives (1 man, 1 woman) per county within the department, who then vote for their departmental President</p> <p>Note: Does not apply to Paris - both a city and a department in itself.</p>
<i>Régionales</i>	6 years	2021	Regional representatives by department who then vote for the regional President
<i>Législatives - Assemblée Nationale</i>	5 years	2017	<p>577 deputies (one deputy per legislative district)</p> <p>Note: General Assembly can be dissolved by the President of the Republic, meaning new elections.</p>
<i>Sénatoriales</i>	6 years	2017	<p>348 senators elected by Departmental and Regional Representatives (only elections which are through indirect vote)</p> <p>Note: Half of the Senate is renewed every 3 years.</p>
<i>Présidentielles</i>	5 years	2017	President of the Republic
<i>Européennes</i>	5 years	2019	<p>French Representatives for European Parliament in 8 districts regrouping several French regions.</p> <p>Note: Only elections that include only one round.</p>
